Cardinal Preschool Immunization Requirements

Before a child may attend school or child care, the family must provide a Washington State Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form. This form shows the child's vaccinations or proof of immunity to disease.

There are a couple of ways families can submit a valid CIS form:

- Families can print their child's CIS form by following the instructions on the <u>Access your Family's Immunization Information</u> web page. This will show you how to get immunization records from MyIR. Please choose the CIS option and not the printout.
- Families can ask a health care provider to print out a **CIS form** for them.
- Families can fill out the CIS form themselves and attach medical records showing vaccination.

Please do not submit a print out of immunization records from your doctor without the **CIS form** attached and signed

Exemptions: Only Medical Exemptions are allowed, we do not accept Religious Exemptions.

Seattle Archdiocese Immunization Policy effective January 1, 2020

Prior to entry, attendance, or transfer to a Level 1 Catholic preschool through high school in the Archdiocese of Seattle, students must present proof of having had the immunizations as required by Washington State law.

Every student enrolled in a Level 1 Catholic School in the Archdiocese of Seattle shall be immunized against vaccine preventable diseases caused by infectious agents in accordance with the immunization schedule adopted by the Washington State Department of Health Services. The only exception to the foregoing requirements for students in our Catholic schools is a medical exemption signed by a licensed physician (M.D., N.D., D.O., ARNP, or PA) authorized to practice in the State of Washington, including the physicians license number.
